Letter from the Library Board

Dear Neighbor,

The library board of trustees will hold its next meeting on **Monday, October 28**, to review the proposed repairs and improvements to our facilities that we are considering and the costs. The meeting will be held at the Mastics-Moriches-Shirley Community Library on William Floyd Parkway in Shirley and will start at 7:00 pm.

The library board has finalized a new renovation proposal to present to the community.

Main Library Building

The plan would fully restore and repair the main library building, which is over 35 years old. We would be making major technological upgrades as well.

Mastic Beach Branch

The library is also proposing to make improvements to the building we recently purchased in Mastic Beach. The goal is to renovate and expand this facility to a 7,000 sq foot branch on Neighborhood Road.

Moriches Branch

The William Floyd School District has offered the library access to 3 or 4 acres along Montauk Highway in Moriches. Our plan is to construct a 7,000 sq foot branch in Moriches to service the growing population of the eastern portion of the library district.
